## STAFF CHILDCARE

The David's Harp Foundation uses the power of music and video production to mentor at-risk, homeless and incarcerated teens. The COVID crisis has intensified the challenges faced by these kids, and DHF has responded by ramping up their love and support. In addition to weekly classes in their studio and in Juvenile Detention, they launched a Learning Hub for their students, providing a safe study space, reliable internet, school supplies and tutors.

Harbor wants to care for the DHF team in this time of extra effort. In addition to donating the use of our Children's Church space to help meet staff parenting needs, this Special Offering will fund a childcare worker's salary for 5 months.
