

### When Suffering Comes from Ourselves and Others

John 4:1-42

<sup>3</sup> Jesus left Judea and departed again for Galilee. <sup>4</sup> And he had to pass through Samaria.

<sup>28</sup> So the woman left her water jar and went away into town and said to the people, <sup>29</sup> "Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?"
